Ballistic Sports Group, Inc. Financial Aid Terms and Conditions

Objective: Ballistic Sport Group, Inc., provides interested and motivated youth the opportunity to play lacrosse at the level that fits their skill and ability. We strive to keep lacrosse affordable, so all youth have an opportunity to participate. As such, the Ballistic Sports Group, Inc., Financial Aid program is intended to provide opportunities for financially disadvantaged youth players to participate in our Summer and Fall programs.

Privacy: All Financial Aid applications and financial documentation information provided will be kept CONFIDENTIAL. For the privacy of our applicants, all documentation provided will be destroyed or returned (upon request) after the application process is completed.

Guidelines: Financial need must be demonstrated for consideration. Economic hardship will be the only factor in awarding Financial Aid. No one will be disqualified from consideration because of sex, race, color, creed or religious beliefs. While we try to address as much of the need as possible, Financial Aid amounts will be based on the number of players demonstrating need, the extent of that need and the budget available for Financial Aid that season.

Financial Aid awards will be reviewed on a seasonal. Financial assistance will be considered on a first come, first served basis and once the financial assistance funds are gone for a particular season, no more aid can be given. In order to spread the assistance as far as possible, we ask each family seeking aid to pay as much as they can afford. Ballistic Sports Group, Inc., is committed to maintaining low registration fees so that more players have the opportunity to play lacrosse. This commitment to low registration fees means that the number and amount of registration fee scholarships is limited. Please realize that a request must be submitted for each season (i.e. Summer and Fall), and that the receipt of financial assistance in one season does not guarantee assistance or the amount thereof in future seasons.

Legal: All applications, applicants, and Ballistic Sports Group, Inc., a not-for-profit organization, are subject to the laws of the State of Florida. Willfully misrepresenting any information on this application is punishable as fraud under FSS. Any disputes will be under the jurisdiction of the Lee County Court. Applicant shall be responsible for legal and court fees for both parties should litigation for non-payment, misrepresentation or any other issue be brought to court.

Criteria and Eligibility:

To be considered you must:

1. Complete and submit an application for Financial Aid.
2. Supply copies of the following (include copies for all individuals contributing to household income):
 - a. Most recent year's Federal Income Tax Form (i.e. 1040 Form).*
 - b. Two most recent (consecutive) pay check stubs for each working parent and household member (or proof of EDD or Disability).
 - c. Social Security Income
 - d. Disability Income
 - e. Child Support/ADC/food stamps/Unemployment

*What if I haven't filed Federal Income Taxes? For a non-filer of Federal Income Tax, contact the Internal Revenue Service at 1-800-829-8374 to request a letter of verification of non-filing status and submit it with your financial assistance application.

3. Please include any additional documentation demonstrating financial need.
4. Applications received after the published deadline will not be considered.
5. Applications that are not filled out completely will not be considered.

6. Applications for financial assistance must be made by a player's parent or guardian. Applications for Financial Aid cannot be filled out by coaches, team managers, children or friends.
7. Any unpaid registration fees from prior seasons will result in an applicant being ineligible for Financial Aid.
8. Commitment to attend a minimum of 80% of scheduled practices and all tournaments, unless injury or illness prevents participation (doctor's note required).
9. It is expected that a family receiving financial assistance will be willing to volunteer to assist the organization or their team by either assisting with stats at tournaments (2 parents needed for each team), stats entry onto the website, serving as a team parent, and helping at the apparel booth during tournaments. Please let us know if there are circumstances that would prevent family members from helping in this way. Financial Aid recipients must complete one of the required volunteer items listed. Not fulfilling the required volunteer time will make the applicant ineligible for future Financial Aid.
10. Financial assistance to a player/family may be terminated if the financial situation is resolved, funds become unavailable, or if the player is deemed in conflict with requirements for player commitment or behavior.
11. After Financial Aid is awarded, the remaining balance of player registration and other applicable fees are to be paid in full on or before the first practice of the season in which aid is awarded, unless a payment schedule is in place. Failure to maintain financial good standing with Ballistic Sports Group, Inc., will result in a player being ineligible to participate.
